NHK Symphony Orchestra seeks the position of 1(one) 2nd/3rd Trombone player

1. Screening dates:

2) 1st Audition (by section)

1st Round/ Tenor Trombone Saturday, February 21st, 2026 (starting at 10:00) 2nd Round/ Bass Trombone Sunday, February 22nd, 2026 (starting at 10:00)

*This 1st audition will be held in the first and second rounds of screening.

The second round of screening takes place with those who have passed the first round.

<Pieces for 1st audition>

- a) Set piece
 - F. David/ Trombone Concertino, Op.4 1st movement and 2nd movement (Publisher: Zimmermann)
- b) Orchestral excerpts (the scores will be sent to those who pass the document screening.)

<Pieces for 2nd audition>

- a) Orchestral excerpts (the scores will be sent to those who pass the document screening.)
- 3) 2nd Audition (decided by the whole orchestra)

3. Please note:

- 1) For the 1st audition (1st round) and 2nd audition, a piano accompanist should be arranged by the applicant.
- 2) Those who pass the document screening will be notified by <u>Saturday, January 31st, 2026.</u>

 No telephone inquiries will be accepted.
- 3) The successful candidates from the first audition will be notified by Tuesday, February 24th, 2026.
- 4) All individual expenses for the audition shall be borne by applicant.
- 5) Submitted documents (résumé and letter of recommendation) are non-returnable.

After the screening and auditions, submitted documents by all applicants except those of a successful applicant shall be shredded and disposed with caution.

4. How to apply:

- 1) Résumé(Application form) including your name and current address, date of birth, contact details (mobile phone number and email address where you can be reached during the daytime), history of study (names of teachers studied under), professional career, awards received and a recent photo.

The NHK Symphony Orchestra (Public Interest Incorporated Foundation) will properly handle personal information entrusted to us during the recruitment screening process as follows based on Japanese laws and regulations.

1. Purpose of use:

disclose any information related to hiring decisions.
